Aliya Khan is a Professor of Clinical Medicine at McMaster University, Director of the Calcium Disorders Clinic and the Fellowship in Metabolic Bone Disease at McMaster University. She graduated from the University of Ottawa Medical School with honors and completed postgraduate training at the University of Toronto. She has published over 200 scientific papers and numerous chapters and books on osteopo-

rosis and parathyroid disease. She has received numerous national and international awards including the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Medal for excellence, International Hypoparathyroidism Award, International Osteoporosis Foundation award for publishing excellence and recognized by Osteoporosis Canada for outstanding contributions to research and education. She was recognized as being in the top 0.1% of the world experts in hyperparathyroidism by Expertscape.

Symposium Objectives:

- 1. Improve recognition of High Risk individuals without the need for BMD's.
- 2. Non-pharmacological strategies to decrease fracture risk.
- 3. Pharmacological treatments appropriate for the frail population with multiple comorbidities and polypharmacy.
- 4. How to apply the Fracture Risk Scale or FRAX in the frail elderly.
- 5. Urgency to treat high risk Osteoporotic elderly residents.
